Aunt Ruby's German Green	Beefsteak	Green		80 days Heirloom Indeterminate	One of the largest green beefsteaks. Can grow to over 1 pound and are just delicious. They have brilliant, neon-green flesh with a strong, sweet, and fruity flavor, much tastier than most red tomatoes. This family heirloom from Germany is beautiful. The winner of the 2003 Heirloom Garden Show's taste test.
Better Boy	Slicer	Red		80 days Indeterminate	Large, delicious, bright red, high yielding fruits are borne in abundance starting midseason and continuing to frost. Good foliage protection prevents sun scald. Better Boy is highly adaptable and thrives in most climates and has very good disease resistance.
Black Krim	Flattened Globe	Purple/Black		75 days Heirloom Indeterminate	The Black Krim is an heirloom tomato originating from the Russian Federation. The plant is open-pollinated, indeterminate, bearing 8 ounce flattened globe fruits that are dark reddish-purple to black with green/brown shoulders.
Black Sea Man	Salad/Slicer	Mahogany with green shoulders		75 days Heirloom Determinante	A Russian Heirloom tomato. Tomatofest certified organic tomato seeds produce small determinant, potato-leaf plants that yield an abundant set of 12-16 ounce beautiful tomatoes that are rich mahogany colored with olive green shoulders when mature. Inside of tomato is deep, reddish green and loaded with excellent, full-bodied, complex, intense, creamy tomato flavors. This is an outstanding tomato for sandwiches and salads. Black Sea Man heirloom tomato does well growing in mid-sized containers. A great early black tomato.

Brad's Black Heart	Heart-shaped	Purple/black		75 days Heirloom Indeterminate	Originated from Brad Gates of Wild Boar Farms in California who found it in a patch of Black Krim and stabilized the seed. Our TomatoFest organic tomato seeds produce indeterminate, droopy regular-leaf plants that yield copious amounts of 12 oz., pink-black, heart-shaped tomatoes (mostly flattened hearts...some pointy, some blunt) with exceptionally rich sweet complex flavors, typical of the best of the black tomatoes. A good producer in cooler growing regions as well as warmer regions. A Gary Ibsen Favorite. If you like the big, robust flavors of the black tomatoes you will want this one in your garden. Disease resistant.
Brandywine	Beefsteak	Red/scarlet		82 days Heirloom Indeterminate	Meaty, smooth and sweet tasting, Brandywine is credited with inspiring the current fascination with heirloom tomato varieties. Dating back to the 1850s, it is a relatively late producer of fruits — with superb flavor that makes them well worth the wait.
German Johnson	Beefsteak	Red		80 days Heirloom Indeterminate	A large, prolific plant originating in Virginia and North Carolina. Thought to be one of the four parent lines of "Radiator Charlie's Mortgage Lifter." Big, leafy, robust plants that produces huge, 1 lb., pink, beefsteak type tomatoes The flavor is excellent. A very popular farmers' market tomato. A wonderful sandwich tomato. Good disease resistance.
Glacier Salad	Salad	Red		55 days Semi-determinate	Produces high yields of medium-sized orange-red saladette tomatoes. Sets fruit at 24" tall and keeps producing all season long. Great for the small garden or containers. Potato-leaf foliage.
Green Zebra	Salad	Green/Yellow Striped		70 days Heirloom Indeterminate	A delicious, tangy salad tomato, ripe just as the green fruit develops a yellow blush, accentuating the darker green stripes. The 3-4 oz. fruits are the ideal size for slicing into wedges for salads. Productive over a long season. Developed by Tom Wagner. Though technically not an heirloom, we feel this is the best place to list it. Indeterminate.
Indian Moon	Globe	Golden		75 days Heirloom Indeterminate	A Navajo heirloom. Good production of beautiful, blemish free, medium-sized, 6-8 oz., golden- globed, meaty and flavorful fruit..

Indigo Apple	Globe	Black/Purple		75 days Indeterminate	Rich in the powerful antioxidant anthocyanin, these large, stunning fruits offer mild, aromatic tomato flavor improved by full ripening from shiny black to matte purple. Resists cracking and sunscald, with some resistance to late blight. Bred by Brad Gates using an original cross made by PKS Heirlooms in Copemish, MI. 4-6 oz.
Lemon Boy	Oblate	Yellow		72 days Heirloom Indeterminate	Lemon yellow, not golden in color. Highly adaptable plants yield large, deep oblate fruits, averaging 6 to 7 oz. and about 3-1/2" across. Out-yields all other "golden" tomatoes available. Mild flavored and adds an inviting color to salads.
San Marzano	Plum	Red		80 days Heirloom Indeterminate	A little later than Roma, with superb flavor in slightly rectangular-shaped fruits, 3-1/2" x 1-1/2", that are bright red and hang in large clusters. Holds well on the vine and in storage. Extra-high solid content is perfect for canning.
Snowball	Flattened Globe	White		75 days Heirloom Indeterminate	Snowball is a rare heirloom tomato. Our TomatoFest seeds produce indeterminate plants that yield very heavy crops of 8-12 oz., 2 1/2" to 3", yellow-white, somewhat flattened round tomatoes with very mild sweet flavors. Delicious! A good choice for folks who want low-acid tomatoes. One of the whitest tomatoes I've grown with creamy white skin and flesh. Produces fruit well into the cooler end of season. Perfect choice for slicing, canning, or even making tomato juice. Also good for making a sweet white pasta sauce.
Snowberry	Cherry	Yellow White		75 days Heirloom Indeterminate	Nicely rounded, 1-1/2 to 2 oz., firm fruits feature a creamy yellow color outside with a white inside, making this unique variety the closest thing to a pure white cherry available on the market today. Sturdy plants produce trusses of uniform fruits and are sweet and fruity with a typical tomato flavor.

Steak Sandwich	Slicer	Red		70 days Indeterminate	These large, luscious beauties offer old-fashioned tomato taste for sandwiches and salads. They remain firm when ripe, so you can slip a slice into your favorite summer sandwich, BLT or burger and savor the rich, succulent, sweet taste. The vigorous compact plants load up with dozens of fruit at a time, a bounty continuing from midsummer to early fall.
